

## ANGUS AREA ACCREDITED TIME TRIALS 2011

<b>Dates</b>	<b>Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2011</b>
<b>Times</b>	Session 1 Sunday 09.00 Warm up for 09.30 Start Session 2 Sunday 13.00 Warm up for 13.30 Start Please note session times may be adjusted once entries are known
<b>Venue</b>	Arbroath Sports Centre. 6 Lanes, Anti-turbulence Lane Ropes (and full electronic timing)
<b>Age Groups</b>	10 years 11 years, 12 years 14 years –age at end of 2011
<b>Events</b>	(HDW) Heat Declared Winner 10 years all strokes + 100 IM (may enter up to 3 events) 11 years 200m all strokes, 200m IM, 400m Freestyle (may enter up to 4 events) 13/14 years 200m all strokes 200 IM 400m fc (may enter up to 5 events) Entries are invited from swimmers who wish to gain qualifying times for the Bronze squad (11 years and over), Angus Area Squad (11 years and over) or Angus Development squad (10/11 years) Swimmers may not enter an event if they already hold a qualifying time. <b>Entries by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> June. £2 per event.</b>
<b>Accreditation</b>	Licence and Level 2 Accreditation
<b>SASA</b>	All swimmers must be current registered swimming members of SASA and of Angus Area Clubs.
<b>Registration</b>	
<b>Consideration/ Qualifying times</b>	See Attached Sheet. These are minimum qualifying times for each event. If necessary the number of heats in each event may be restricted to ensure the meet runs to the licensed timescale. In which case priority will be given to those swimmers who are trying for bronze squad times. Over the top starts will be used other than in Backstroke events.
<b>Marshalling</b>	It is hoped that a marshalling system will be in place. Coaches are requested to listen carefully to all announcements and send swimmers to marshal three heats in advance of their swim.
<b>Officials/Helpers</b>	In order for the meet to be accredited at level two we require the following number of officials-Referee, Starter, Recorder, 8Judges and 18 timekeepers (this number required if electronic equipment not used), and ask that all clubs seek to help in the provision of officials. Assistance of any sort in the running of the meet is much appreciated, and volunteers are required to help with Marshalling/computers/ door and juice. Contact Marion Durham, Laura Ross or Scott Haxton if you are available to assist in any way. Anyone assisting at 2 sessions per day and requiring lunch, should be aware that catering requirements must be notified 2 weeks in advance. Officials will assemble for briefing sessions in a venue which will be announced. A list of duties will be posted in advance and officials are requested to report at least 15 minutes in advance of the start time of the gala for briefing. All designated Recorders should report to the Championship Convenor ½ hour in advance of the start of the session. Club are reminded that announcing is a requirement for accreditation at Levels 2.

Fastest consideration times for the Angus Area Time Trials June 2011 are shown below. Swimmers with times faster than those shown will NOT be accepted. No Refunds will be made for incorrectly entered swimmers. The Angus Area swimming development group reserves the right to restrict the number of heats to ensure a good level of competition and adherence to meet timings.

Entry Times must be SLOWER than those shown.

The number of heats in these events will be at the discretion of the Meet Organiser and will depend on the number of entries received and programme timing.

It is hoped that by the introduction of this time trial event that we are able to give swimmers within the Angus area the local opportunity to aid with qualification for the Scottish Swimming Bronze Squad and the various Angus Area squads. The events for age 11-14 are based on the rationale behind the bronze squad and therefore the events are 200m + only. Due to time restraints and the increased possibility of swimmers aged 14 more likely to have had the opportunity to make 100m times elsewhere these events are not included in this programme despite this age group permitted one 100m time. This year the programme is very much a trial and should the Angus Swim development group agree to run it in following years we hope to work on feedback received from coaches and swimmers on its layout.

No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area under the control of the meet organisers without prior approval of the meet manager. Please note this also includes mobile phones with internal cameras. Applications for permission to use photographic equipment must be made on the approved SASA form obtainable from the Meet Desk.
